- Broader understanding of community needs.
- 2. Improved decision-making quality.
- Better access to skills, tools, and knowledge found within your community.
- 4. Heightened community trust in town officials and the planning process.

- 6. Much more!

Meaningful Involvement Means:

- ✓ People have an opportunity to participate in decisions about activities that may affect their environment and/or health
- ✓ The public's contribution can influence the regulatory agency's decision
- ✓ Community concerns will be considered in the decision-making process
- Decision makers will seek out and facilitate the involvement of those potentially affected (U.S. EPA)

Your whole community benefits when everyone is able to participate in town matters.

Tips to Increase Participation:

- Offer childcare, food, compensation and/or transportation to encourage broad participation in community meetings.
- 2. Honor lived experiences, technical expertise, AND academic information.
- Choose locations and methods of publicizing meeting details (e.g. Front Porch Forum, town bulletin boards) that function to increase inclusivity.
- 4. Solicit feedback outside of meetings in order to gather information from those who were unable to attend.
