This 4-day course is a training opportunity for local officials responsible for administering their local floodplain regulations. The course will focus on the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) and concepts of floodplain management, maps and studies, bylaw administration, and the relationship between floodplain management and flood insurance. This is the field-deployed version of FEMA's E273 course that is offered at the Emergency Management Institute (EMI).

**Target Audience:** This course is geared towards local officials who administer their floodplain regulations and have limited floodplain management experience. Others are encouraged to attend, including Town Managers/Administrators, community planners, zoning administrators, community board members, attorneys, engineers or surveyors, and public works officials.

\*Class size is capped at 35 participants, & you must commit to attending all 4 days. Preference will be given to VT local floodplain managers if the class is filled beyond capacity. A follow-up email will confirm your seat and registration.

**CFM Exam:** The Certified Floodplain Manager (CFM) exam is now offered online only. Exam takers will need to <u>register separately</u> with ASFPM.

ASFPM recommends exam takers review the materials on the <u>CFM Exam</u> <u>Resources</u> prior to sitting for the exam.
